WHAT WE CAN ASSIST WITH...

- Fines & Infringements
- Criminal Law (minor)
- Identity Documents (including ImmiCards and interstate and Overseas Birth certificates)
- Criminal Injuries Compensation
- Police Complaints
- Restraining Orders
- Debts
- Early Release of Superannuation
- Discrimination

WHAT WE MAY BE ABLE TO ASSIST WITH...

- Advice about driver's License issues
- What to do when someone dies
- Housing issues
- Warm referrals to other services

WHAT WE CANNOT ASSIST WITH...

- Bankruptcy/ insolvency
- Family Law (including property settlement/child custody)

WHAT IS 'AT RISK' OF HOMELESSNESS?

Street Law considers a person at risk of homelessness when they have a legal issue that places them at significant and immediate risk of losing their accommodation. We will take into consideration whether legal intervention will directly prevent them from becoming homeless.
